Sacrament Information

Infant Baptism: A preparation program for parents and godparents is required. Once paperwork is submitted, we will register you for preparation and schedule the date for Baptism.

First Reconciliation & First Eucharist: Customarily the reception of these sacraments takes place during 2nd grade. The child will need to have completed one year of religious education the year immediately prior to sacramental preparation and will continue in religious education concurrent with the preparation classes.

Confirmation: Candidates must be in the 9th grade or above to be confirmed. The candidate will need to have completed one year of youth group the year immediately prior to Confirmation preparation. They will also need to attend youth group the year of preparation. Preparation for adult Confirmation takes place in April. Confirmation will take place in May.

Marriage: Please call the Parish Office at least six months in advance to begin the preparation process. You will set the date for the wedding at the first meeting.

Anointing of the Sick: Please contact the parish office to arrange visitation and sacraments. You may leave a message any time of day or night and someone will get back to you as soon as possible.

Here is some stuff coming up that I'd like you to consider being a part of: **Parish Mission:** For the first time in a long time, our local parishes will be hosting a parish mission. A parish mission is sort of like a revival. We will have a visiting priest who will offer Masses at St. Rose on the weekend of March 7th and 8th. Then, on March 9th and 10th he will offer a couple of talks which will inspire us all to live the faith.




